I-AMMO WG



- I-AMMO WG Tasked to develop logistics data to fulfill users (MNC) requirements due to increased multinational operational environments (Storage, Transportation and Interchangeability)
- Main Catalogue is AOP-6

What is AOP-6?



- AOP-6 Volume I is a document supporting NATO Commands and Nations that lists ammunition that is interchangeable among the NATO nations. It is designed to be used when national shortfalls arise which may hamper the effectiveness of operations. Ammunition items listed in AOP-6 Vol. I satisfy interchangeability criteria of form, fit, and function only. Function is defined as the physical action, role or purpose of a nature of ammunition
- AOP-6 Volume II specifies approved ammunition based on National evaluation/testing and a signed National Interchangeability Document (NID) that can be used safely and reliably in training and operations, without further authorization




- National inventories of ammunition (Small to Large caliber, Missiles, Rockets, Explosives and Demolition) produced by selected nation(s), that are interchangeable between two or more nations
- National Inventories of ammunition produced by other nations, that are interchangeable between two or more nations
- Interchangeability information searchable by a Fuze, Cartridge, National Stock Number (NSN), Nations' Abbreviation Short Code, (FSC, DODIC), Weapon, Ammunition's Caliber, NATO Ammunition Reporting Code (NARC), NARC's Description, Remarks (Key word(s) and Nations

What is a NARC?




- A Five Digit Code System
 - First three digits Chapter
 - Fourth Digit ammunition's Function (i.e. HE, Smoke, Tracer)
 - Fifth Digit Serial Number
 - Ammunition are interchangeable only within the 5 Digit NARC
- NARCs are assigned by the AOP-6 Custodian




- World Wide Ammunition Reporting System (WARS), Rock Island
- Conventional Ammunition Interchangeability Substitutability List (CASIL), Rock Island
- Item Managers/SME from Picatinny and other US Commands
- ▶ Software checks AOP-6 NSNS & DODICs against WARS & CASIL
 - All NSNs and DODICs in AOP-6 Should be in WARS & CASIL






AOP-6(T) Vol. I I (NID)

User Requirements for Ammunition Interchangeability



- Single Source Ammunition Data Base, Combination of:
 - Logistic Functional Services (LOG FS)
 Transportation & Storage information
 - AOP-6 Vol. I and AOP-40(Ammunition Data sheets, Not yet available) Interchangeability Information
 - SHAPE's technical experts are looking into the possibility of linking LOG FS with AOP-6 Vol. I
- Nations to provide their ammunition data for all services (Land, Air and Sea) for incorporation in AOP-6 and AOP- 40

User Requirements for Ammunition Interchangeability



- Nations to provide their NIDs for incorporation in AOP-6 Vol. II
- Future Technical Expert meeting at the Hague, possibly in July to make final decision on linking LOG FS with AOP-6 Vol. I



► Electronic Version can answer the following Questions:



- Which NATO Nations have 30MM Ammunition in their inventories?
- Which 30MM ammunition can be interchanged between BE and the UK?
- ▶ Which NATO Nations have ammunition with the following NSN: 1310-00-309-4935?
- Which ammunition can be interchanged with the selected ammunition (1310-00-309-4935)?
- ▶ Which weapons can be used to fire the ammunition?



- Which small Ammunition are produced by France?
- Which NATO Nations are using small arms ammunition produced by FR?
- What are all weapons (Machine Gun, Cannon, Rifle) used by a selected Nation to fire all the ammunition in its inventory?
- Which NATO Nations use a particular weapon?



- What ammunition can be interchanged between BE, FR, UK and US?
- What new ammunition have been submitted in the latest AOP-6 catalogue?
- All [Small arms, Tank Gun and All Artillery] Ammunition can be interchanged between TU, GR and DA?
- Which ammunition are listed with a "Do Not Fire" restriction?
- Which Small Arms ammunition are NATO Qualified?
