

## SI Explorer's Drag & Drop


 SI Explorer now provides the capability to drag & drop sections from Windows Explorer to the SI Explorer.




 Provides capability to Search / Replace text for an entire Job.

Uppercase




 Provides capability to Search / Replace text for an entire Job.






These files are the ACTUAL Section files, do not delete them. Once you Exit SpecsIntact the folder will be removed.

#### Global Settings


- Allows you to store specific settings with a Job
- Units of Measure Options
  - Controls the SI Editors view options as well as the Process/Print options
- Revisions Option
  - Sets the SI Editor to automatically use and view Revisions



## Publishing - PDF and Word


- Built in Feature to Publish the Guide Specifications to PDF or Word
  - Must first select the Project Table of Contents and/or Section Table of Contents





### Publishing - PDF and Word

- Publishing to PDF
  - Features:
    - Bookmark Sections
    - Bookmark SectionTable of Contents
    - Ability to Combine Job into one PDF document

#### XIVIL


- XML is now a mainstream technology
  - Industry is rapidly adopting
  - AG, IBM, Sun, Microsoft, Netscape,
     DataChannel, SAP and many others have already announced support for XML
- Will provide more flexibility and benefits
- Providing a Style Sheet allows the display of well formed documents in most browsers

#### XIVIL

- Anticipate SpecsIntact to be *fully* XML compliant by the next scheduled software release
- The new software will work with both the new XML and older SGML formats simultaneously and transparently
- The new XML format will be incompatible with prior SpecsIntact software versions
- The XML Guide Specifications and software will be released and distributed at the same time

#### User Counting

- Developed to obtain an actual count of SpecsIntact Users
  - Launches first time SpecsIntact
     v4.1.0.653 is installed
