

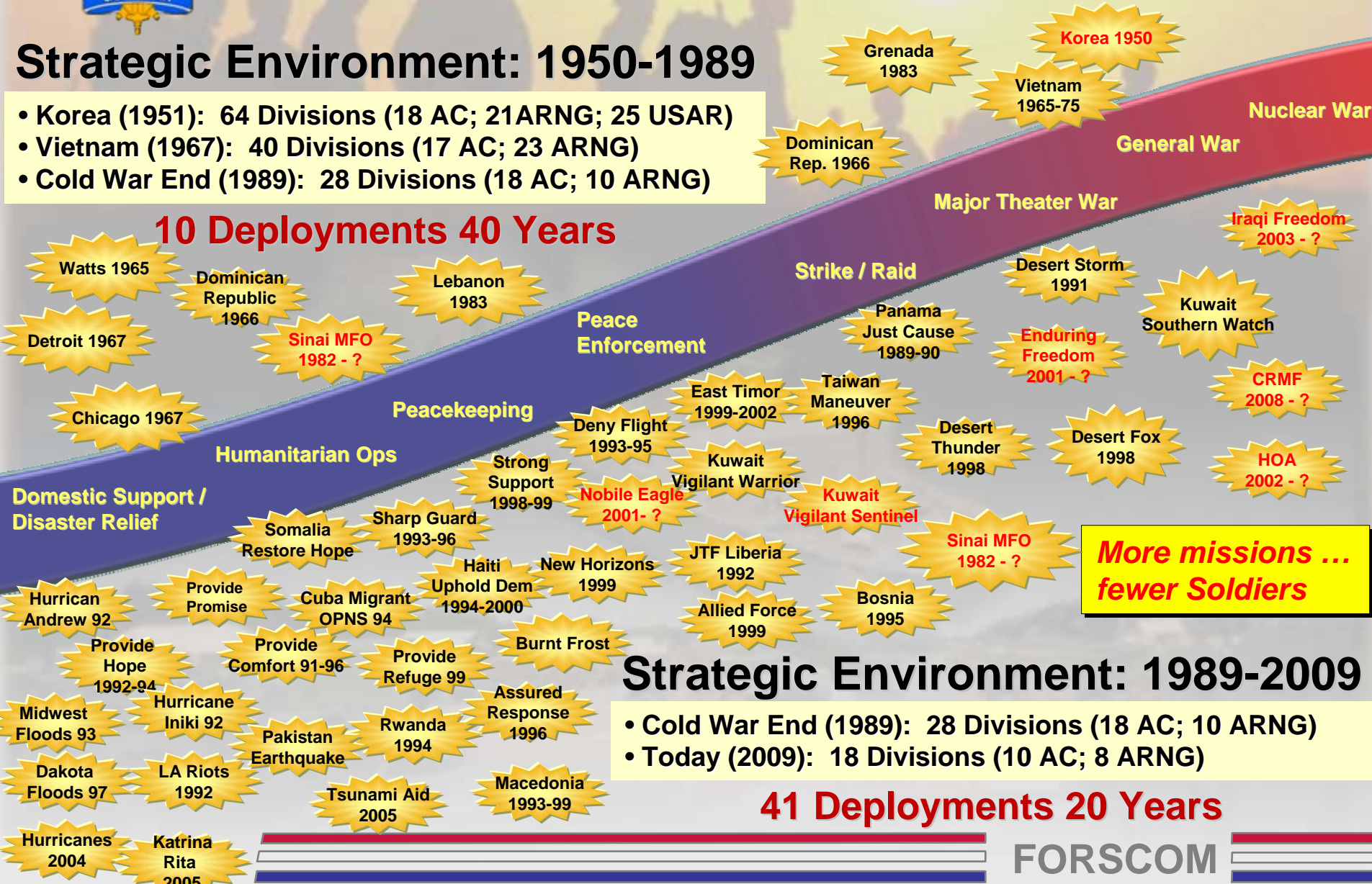


# US ARMY FORCES COMMAND

- Vietnam (1967): 40 Divisions (17 AC; 23 ARNG)

- ❑ Operational Reserve Component
- ❑ Retrograde of Units and Equipment
- ❑ Budget Constraints
- ❑ Increased Acquisition Requirements and Scrutiny -- No Corresponding Increase in Active Duty Workforce
