# S&T Mission

---

- **S&T Mission**
  - Strengthen America's security and resiliency by providing knowledge products and innovative technology solutions for the Homeland Security Enterprise (HSE)
  
- **Achieving the S&T Mission**
  - *Operationally focused* ... S&T provides the HSE with strategic and focused technology options and operational process enhancements
  - *Innovative* ... S&T seeks innovative, systems-based solutions to complex homeland security problems
  - *Partnerships* ... S&T has the technical depth and reach to discover, adapt and leverage technology solutions developed by federal agencies and laboratories, state, local and tribal governments, universities, and the private sector - across the US and internationally



- Current Situation
  - Billions being spent to improve equipment readiness and preparedness through DHS Grant Programs
  - Honest broker information needed
  - DHS established SAVER Program - initially at FEMA transferred to S&T 01/09
- The SAVER Program assists Federal, State, & local responders making procurement decisions
- The SAVER Program:
  - Conducts impartial, practitioner relevant, and operationally oriented assessments and validations of emergency responder equipment
  - Provides information that enables decision makers and responders to better select, procure, use, and maintain emergency responder equipment



- Over **850** Knowledge Products are currently available through SAVER
- Approximately **248** publication approved by S&T since Jan 2009 (date of transfer from FEMA)
- Over **535** individual products assessed since inception of SAVER
- Currently, approximately **4500** publications downloaded/requested from SAVER ([www.rkb.us/SAVER](http://www.rkb.us/SAVER)) per month.
