EXPEDITIONARY WARFARE COMMANDER (EXWC) BATTLESPACE

- CLEAR** the battlespace of explosive, security and physical hazards; shaping the security environment
- BUILD** partnerships leading to domain access through assured C2 and critical infrastructure development
- SECURE** the battlespace, throughout the littorals, for U.S., joint and coalition partner access and action
- PROTECT** from threats through Battlespace Awareness and Integrated Fires
