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






PB24 Base Budget Outlook (FY24-FY28)

- Replenishing of legacy w/ modernized capability

Efforts in Supply Chain Risk Management (SCRM)

- \checkmark Identified and addressed near-term risks in portfolio
 - Smoke Grenade Dye: developed domestic pilot-scale process
 @ Synthio
 - BDNP A/F: series of investment to stand-up production (SBIR, LCPP, PA)
- ✓ 2020 effort to address supply chain resiliency added proactive initiatives reviewed monthly
 - Conducting TDP scrub in the last year of an existing production contract
- Active member of cross-JPEO "Assured Munitions" IPT
- Assessing inclusion of Equitable Price Adjustment for all contracting efforts
- Assessing OSD Defense Production Act (DPA) Title III Industrial Base Analysis and Sustainment opportunities
- Looking to pilot SCRM contract requirements on new developments: XM250 CTSO, XM919 IAM, XM123 GOBLN


